Table of Plenty Code of Conduct

Table of Plenty provides a welcoming and supportive environment for guests and volunteers which respects our guests' privacy and dignity at all times. Everyone is welcome to our meal, and our goal is for all guests and volunteers to feel a sense of belonging and enjoy each other's companionship during each and every meal.

We do not tolerate verbal or physical harassment, disrespectful behavior toward other guests or volunteers, or any behavior that interferes with anyone's ability to volunteer or enjoy the meal. Complying with this code of conduct is mandatory for all guests and volunteers who come to Table of Plenty. Those who fail to comply may be asked to leave the meal and possibly prohibited from attending future meals.

Expected Conduct

Be kind and respectful. Be excellent to fellow guests and volunteers. Treat them with kindness and respect at all times. Avoid causing disturbances or disruptions.

Create a welcoming environment. Foster a welcoming environment and invite others to join your table. Use common courtesy when interacting with guests and volunteers.

Do not harass others. Do not engage in any kind of verbal or physical harassment, threatening behavior, intimidation, bullying, or insulting language. If someone asks you to stop doing something and you continue doing it, that's harassment and will not be tolerated.

Do not engage in violent behavior. Any form of violent behavior is prohibited.

Respect the privacy and dignity of guests. Do not photograph or otherwise record guests at the meal without their consent. Do not share with people outside of the meal who attends the meal without their consent – some may want to keep private that they come to Table of Plenty.

Remain in public areas. Remain in public areas unless invited to another space in the Senior Center.

Do not bring alcohol or other substances. Smoking, drinking alcohol, or being impaired by any substance is prohibited.
